German	<p>Please see separate sheet;</p> <p>There are a number of grammatical points which you should revise and practise regularly. Firstly, read through your notes to understand when to use the particular point and then how to form / use it making sure that you are clear about any word order changes which may be involved. You could write 'cards' to keep as revision tools to help you nearer to exam time or when you are completing homework.</p> <p>You can practise by writing single sentences in German (look in your exercise book for English sentences which you could use to translate) or write a paragraph which will incorporate this specific point.</p> <p>In addition, you should be learning vocabulary on a regular basis – aim for 10 words per session. Write up (including corrections and improvements) to paragraphs you have written in your exercise book. Write them on separate cards and paper and keep them with your revision notes.</p> <p>Topics – family and friends / technology which you use / free time / where you live/ school / future plans / festivals and celebrations / environment.</p>
Art	<p>Please see separate sheet;</p> <p>The work listed is intended as a guide. You will be set homework that appears on this list, you will also be set homework which does not appear on this list. You should aim to do at least 2 hours of work for Art in your own time each week. If nothing specific has been set this does not mean you do not have any homework, it means you should be selecting work from the General Homework category.</p>
